What do you think or feel is supposed to go on during a church service? What is worship?

Describe a worship service when you experienced the presence of God in some way. What was going on? What was it that moved you?

In Matthew 22, Jesus says the kingdom of heaven is like a wedding feast. How would you describe that kind of feast in heaven? What would be going on during the feast?

What is your favorite part of a worship service? How are all of your senses involved in worship? What is the difference between going to a worship service and experiencing worship?

If worship is "bi-directional," and God has already made the first move toward us, in what ways has God made the first move? What is our part in response to God's first move? What do you "bring to the table" in worship?

Read Mark 12:28-34. How can we worship God with our heart (choices), our mind (thoughts & wisdom), our soul (emotions) and our strength (our actions)?

If this is Jesus' recipe for worship, what ingredients do you feel you might be leaving out of your worship time?
