

QUESTIONS FROM THE SERMON AT *THE PATH*
“More Like Falling in Love”

What are the four words for “love” used in the Greek language? How does “agape” love incorporate the other types of love? How does it guide or provide boundaries for the other types of love?

Read Luke 10:25-27. Why would Jesus say that loving God was the greatest commandment? (discuss loving our neighbor another time) Why should God even be concerned about love?

What is the mission statement of our church? Can we love God without knowing Him? Explain. If so, can we know God without loving Him? How do we come to ‘know’ God? How does knowing God relate to the great commandment?

In a courting relationship, how does a person come to know the other person? How does knowing that person influence someone’s feelings? How does this relate to our loving God?

In Ephesians 5 Paul says that human marriage is a symbol of the relationship between Christ and His Church. What qualities and characteristics would be found in a good marriage that might also be found in a good love relationship with God?

Has there ever been a time when you would have said to Jesus, “I’m just not into you”? Has anything changed? Why and How?

If you can remember any of the lyrics of the song, “More Like Falling in Love,” what phrases stick out to you? What is the songwriter saying?
