- What are child-like qualities that would be considered helpful to enter the kingdom of heaven?

- What have you learned from a child lately about being child-like?

- What qualities do you have that would make a child feel welcome in church?

- What qualities do you feel God would need to change in you to make you more child-like in your faith? What child-like qualities do you feel you have?
