Questions from *The Path*

How would you describe the new heaven and new earth that the Bible talks about?

Dr. Martin named 7 aspects of what the redeemed might do in heaven. Look at each one, with any accompanying Scripture (or any others the group might have) and discuss them:

1) We will worship and praise God. The book of Revelation is filled with the worship and praise of God. (Rev. 19:4-8)

2) We will serve God. Rev. 22:3 “The throne of God and of the lamb will be in the city and his servants will serve him.”

3) We will sing. (Rev.15:2-4) What do you feel about singing in heaven? What significance can it have that only the redeemed sing in heaven, and not the angels?

4) We will eat – Read Revelation 19:9. What does it say of a banquet? What significance does eating together have? Read Luke 22:29.

5) We will rest - Hebrews 3:1. Why would rest be associated with heaven? What besides sleep is restful to you?

6) We will work – (Matthew 25:21) What kind of work might God have for us in a new heaven and new earth?

7) We will live in community with others. Revelation talks about the New Jerusalem – a city, a community where believers live. Jesus said in John 14 in my Father’s house are many rooms. What are your thoughts about living in community in heaven?

What aspects of heaven hold the greatest interest or desire for you?

Read Revelations 21:1-8; 22-29. What features of the new heaven and new earth stand out to you?
