Questions from The Path sermon

Give some examples of someone “jumping the gun.”

How can we know the difference between jumping the gun and doing our will, instead of doing the will of God?

Read Exodus 2:11-15a. Why would Moses think that he should act as the deliverer of his people? What did he have going for him? Why was his action contrary to the will of God?

What do you think Moses learned during his time in Midian that prepared him for God’s call from the burning bush? What can we learn from Moses?

It is easy to see that doing anything unethical or immoral will not lead to doing God’s will. How do we determine God’s direction when no sinful choices are made?

Read 2 Corinthians 12:9. This was God’s response to Paul when he prayed for deliverance from his “thorn in the flesh.” How might this help us from jumping the gun in doing God’s will?
