When was the last time you prayed for God’s will? What were the circumstances? How did things turn out?

When we say we want to know God’s will, what are we really saying? What do we want to know?

Read James 1:5-8. How is faith related to knowing God’s will? What is expected of us once we ask?

What Biblical principles do you use to help discern the will of God?

If you knew God’s will in every situation, would you do it? If knew God’s will, why would you even want to do it? What would motivate you? And the flip side of the question: If you knew God’s will why would you decide NOT to do it?

What does Dr. Martin mean when he says, “Knowing God’s will comes out of a relationship?” What are the parallels between a human loving relationship and knowing and doing God’s will?
