THE PATH WORSHIP **Multi-series: LIVE THE MISSION**

Live the Mission Series Part 2: **"Passionately Seeking to Love God"**

Feb. 19 – "Love One Another" – 1 John 4:7-12

The great commandment is to love God and love our neighbor. Jesus also said that He had one new command, that we love one another. How have we failed in this? How have we succeeded? How do we passionately seek to love God by loving one another?

Feb. 26 – "A Liar's Love" 1 John 4:20-21

This will be the first Sunday in Lent. Many say they love God, but there is no evidence of that love in their treatment of others. Every couple goes through ups and downs of feeling love toward one another, but real love is about consistent loving actions. Words and actions must go together. When someone is unloving in their actions, words of love are a lie. This is how we know whether or not we are passionately seeking to love God or not.

March 4 – "Complete Love" – 1 John 4:17-18

The theological understanding of being completely motivated by love is called, "entire sanctification" – perfected in love and totally motivated by love in all things. This is what it means to love like Jesus would love in this world. We have nothing to fear in this world or at the judgment when we live passionately seek to love God in all ways.

Biblical Principles for Financial Wisdom, Courage, and Peace

There is one issue that's on everyone's minds today: the Economy. Fears of defaults in Europe; continued high unemployment in America; stock market jitters that cause huge gyrations in the stock markets; home prices that continue to decline; and an economy that seems to sputter along the edge of recession – they all leave pundits, politicians, and us grasping for answers.

These are times that require wisdom and courage in our personal lives. These are times when rediscovering sound financial practices are the only way to have financial peace. In this sermon series, we will consider these practices, but most importantly, we'll turn to the Bible to listen for its principles for how we can practice financial wisdom. And in so doing, we'll discover serenity and joy in the face of ongoing economic challenges.

Beginning March 11, join us as we examine what it means to live wisely and what courageous changes we need to make in order to live as God would have us live.
